<p>Business arising from previous minutes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A list of local charities has yet to be prepared. An email was sent to Phil Johnston, a response has not been received. JC to follow up with council. 	
<p>Operations update provided by KB:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> TGO progressing well with the U/G operations. No significant development within the operation Ongoing exploration activity near to mine – still no decisions on whether additional pits or underground will be developed. Still waiting on drilling and board decision once results are in. 	

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<p>Community Information and feedback:</p> <p>KB provided and update to the meeting on:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Feedback from Mike Sutherland received that he had discussions with a near to mine neighbour regarding the NSC Tomingley Village Water Tank Project. Mike referred the individual to the Narromine Council, as TGO have no further involvement with this project. • The near neighbour also discussed with Mike Sutherland the makeup of the CCC and that no locals were involved. However, advice received from members present indicated that there was significant representation from Tomingley Village and NSC locals. The Independent Chair asked whether the committee should be opened up for new members however those present indicated that this was not required, due to membership being adequate.

KB indicated that there was no written agreement, however the verbal arrangement was that NSC would request TGO to fill the village dams and TGO would then add water to the dams. SM asked for this information to be provided to her for the next Tomingley Progress Association meeting. • JH asked the group what the general community sentiment was regarding farmers nearby and potential acquisition of properties by Alkane. Generally, it was proffered that most where resigned to the fact that it would happen.
