| <ul> <li>MW provided information to the committee on the discharge from Sediment Basin 1 following the storm event on 2<sup>nd</sup> December 2017.</li> <li>Noise, Dust, Blasting – No exceedances were recorded.</li> <li>Mining no change to operations with works continuing in WY1 with occasional works in Caloma 2. Mining is scheduled to finish August/September depending on ground conditions, work areas and weather.</li> <li>WRE 2 – drainage works on the top of the dump to be completed within a few days.</li> <li>WRE 3 – Pushing down works continuing along with topsoil spreading and construction of drop down drains.</li> <li>Biodiversity – TGO arranged Peak Hill men's shed to build bird nesting boxes. Environment team has commenced installing these within the biodiversity offset areas. TGO supplied all materials and made a contribution to the men's shed of \$50 per box.</li> <li>The Narromine bore field water line is now hooked up to the Tomingley water supply dams. TGO will deliver water to the village when requested by Council.</li> </ul> |   |
| <ul> <li>Community Information and feedback:</li> <li>Underground – No decision has been made in relation to underground as yet.</li> <li>TGO work force is approximately 105 as at end of January with approximately 45 contractors.</li> <li>No complaints have been received since the last meeting.</li> </ul>   |   |
| <ul> <li>General Business:</li> <li>General discussion around water supply and cost of running the pipeline to supply Tomingley when mining finishes entirely. TE advised that it was a concern when he was on Council. MW advised that is the subject of the report provided to council.</li> </ul>   |   |
